ACTION OF HIDDEN VALLEY LAKE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

DATE: October 6, 2020

AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Award of Contract to Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$120,186 for the WWTP Access Road Improvements Project.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Approve the attached resolution which takes the following actions regarding the WWTP Access Road Improvements Project:

- 1. Authorize the Board of Directors to approve a construction contract with Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. for the WWTP Access Road Improvements Project based on their submitted bid of \$120,186.
- 2. Approve the overall Estimated Construction Budget of \$154,205, which includes the construction cost, a 10% contingency and monies for construction management and inspection.
- 3. Determining the project to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Based on the recommended award amount, staff is proposing the following overall budget:

Construction	\$120,186
Construction Contingency (10%)	\$ 12,019
Estimated Construction Management & Inspection	\$ 22,000
Total Estimated Project Construction Budget	\$154,205

Costs associated with this project will be paid from District capital reserve funds.

BACKGROUND: The WWTP Access Road Improvements Project consists of grading and double chip-sealing 2,040 feet of access road between Grange Road and the WWTP entrance gate. The existing road is in a rutted and poor condition. On June 16, 2020, the District authorized Coastland Engineering to prepare construction documents for the project.

In August, the project was advertised for bids in accordance with the requirements of the California Public Contract Code. On September 10, 2020, District staff conducted the bid opening, but no bids were received.

When no bids are received for a project that followed the advertisement and bidding requirements of the Public Contract Code, Section 22038(c) of the Code allows agencies to pursue obtaining bids from selected contractors and the agency no longer has to abide by the bidding and advertising procedures as set forth in the Code. Accordingly, on September 17, District staff invited four local contractors to submit bids. The Board authorized the General Manager to award a construction contract if the cost estimated by a contractor came in at or less than the Engineer's Estimate (\$76,234.) If a contract could not be negotiated for the Engineer's estimate or less, the Board directed that the item be brought back to the Board for approval. Informal bids were requested from the contractors on September 23rd.

During the bidding period, two contractors advised staff that the lifespan of the proposed repair would be greatly improved by adding a 3-inch course of fresh aggregate base rock to the road surface prior to chipsealing. The reasoning was that this new rock material would allow the chip-seal oil to penetrate much more deeply into the roadbed and therefore bind the material together better than the existing road bed material which contains a lot of fine graded rock and silt due to years of wear and tear. Staff concurred with this approach and Addendum #1 was issued which added a bid item for adding 3-inches of new base rock material over the existing roadway (once the existing road bed was graded, shaped and compacted.) Adding 3-inches of new base rock increased the Engineer's Estimate to \$116,344. The bid deadline was extended to September 25, 2020.

On September 25, 2020, District staff conducted the bid opening and one bid was received from Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. for the amount of \$120,186.00, which was slightly in excess of the Engineer's Estimate of \$116,344.

The District Engineer reviewed Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc's bid documents and found them to be responsive and complete.

The award of the contract is to be based on the lowest responsive and responsible bid received. Based on information received, staff is recommending that the District award the contract to Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. for \$120,186 and approve the overall budget for the project.

If approved, the work is estimated to start in October and be completed by October 31, 2020.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH SMITH CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE WWTP ACCESS ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND ESTABLISH AN OVERALL BUDGET

HIDDEN VALLEY LAKE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the WWTP access road between Grange Road and the entry gate to the WWTP is in poor condition; and

WHEREAS, contract bid documents were prepared for the repair of this road and the project was advertised for public bidding in accordance with the regulations of the California Public Contract Code; and

WHEREAS, bids for the project were publicly opened on September 10, 2020, in accordance with Section 4104.5 of the California Public Contract Code and other applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, due to the fact that no bids were received, in accordance with Section 22038(c) of the Public Contract Code, local contractors known to have the capabilities of performing the work were contacted and invited to submit bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, the second bid opening for the project was conducted on September 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received for \$120,186.00 from Smith Construction and General Engineering Inc.; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that the bid from Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. is responsive and satisfies the bidding requirements for the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff has verified that Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. possesses a valid California Contractor's License under the requested Class A, number 731325 (expires 3/31/22) as required to qualify to perform the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been found to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301(b) as it consists of repair of existing facilities of both investor and publicly-owned utilities used to provide electric power, natural gas, sewerage, or other public utility services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District, Lake County, California, as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Community Services District.

- 2. In accordance with the California Public Contract Code Section 20160 et seq., and other applicable laws, the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District hereby finds the bid of Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. for the WWTP Access Road Improvements Project to be the lowest responsive bid and waives any irregularities in such bid in accordance with applicable law.
- 3. The contract for the WWTP Access Road Improvements Project is hereby awarded to Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$120,186.00 conditioned on Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc's timely executing the Project contract and submitting all required documents, including, but not limited to, executed bonds/surety, certificates of insurance, and endorsements, in accordance with the Project bid documents.
- 4. The President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute upon submission by Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc. all documents required pursuant to the Project bid documents for performance of the Project.
- 5. The overall construction budget for the Project be established at \$154,205.00.
- 6. District staff are hereby directed to issue a Notice of Award to Smith Construction and General Engineering, Inc for the project.
- 7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
- 8. All portions of this resolution are severable. Should any individual component of this Resolution be adjudged to be invalid and unenforceable by a body of competent jurisdiction, then the remaining resolution portions shall be and continue in full force and effect, except as to those resolution portions that have been adjudged invalid. The Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District hereby declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase and other portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more section subsection, clause sentence, phrase or other portion may be held invalid or unconstitutional.

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 3400, bidders may propose equals of products listed in the technical specifications or project plans by manufacturer name, brand or model number, unless the technical specifications or plans specify that the product is necessary to match others in use. Complete information for products proposed as equals must be submitted to the District for review at least 10 working days before the time specified for bid opening in accordance with the bidders instructions contained in the bid package.

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20170, all bids must be presented under sealed cover and include one of the following forms of bidder's security: cash, cashier's check made payable to the District, certified check made payable to the District, or a bidder's bond. The amount of bidder's security provided must equal at least ten (10) percent of the total of the bid price for the base bid and the additive or deductive items listed in this notice. The successful bidder must submit to the District complete, executed copies of all required documents within ten (10) working days of receiving written notice of award of the project. Bidder's security of any successful bidder that fails to do so will be forfeited to the District. Such required documents include, but are not limited to, a payment or labor and materials bond in an amount of at least 100 percent of the amount payable by the terms of the project contract and that satisfies the requirements of California Civil Code Section 9554, and a performance bond in an amount of at least 100 percent of the amount payable by the terms of the contract. All project bonds must be executed by an admitted surety insurer in accordance with applicable law and acceptable to the District.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code the Director of Industrial Relations for the State of California has ascertained the current general prevailing rate of wages for

employer purposes, in Lake County, State of California. Not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for work of a similar character in Lake County and not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for holiday work fixed as provided in the California Labor Code shall be paid to all workers engaged in performing the project.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1771.1 of the California Labor Code, a contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the California Labor Code, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Civil Code Section 1725.5. *Please note:* It is not a violation of Section 1771.1 for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded. Any bids submitted without proof that Bidder and any listed subcontractor(s) are currently registered and qualified to perform public work, pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5, shall not be accepted by the District.

In accordance with the California Labor Code Section 1773.2, copies of the applicable determinations are available at the District office and may be reviewed upon request.

In accordance with California Civil Code Section 1771.4, the project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 3300, a valid class A California contractor's license is required to bid on the project.

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 22300, except where prohibited by federal regulations or policies, the successful bidder may, on request and at its expense, substitute securities in lieu of amounts withheld by the District from progress payments to ensure performance under the contract in accordance with the contract documents.

The District reserves the right to postpone the date and time for the opening of proposals at any time prior to the date and time announced in the advertisement in accordance with applicable law.

The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any defects or irregularity in bidding in accordance with applicable law. In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20103.8, if the District elects to award a contract for performance of the project, the contract will be awarded in accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20162 and other applicable law to the responsible bidder submitting a responsive bid with the lowest total bid price for the total base bid without consideration of the bid price for any additive or deductive items. The lowest responsive bidder and any listed subcontractors will be checked to ensure that they are clear from the Federal Procurement and Non-Procurement Program List. All bids will remain valid for 90 days after the bid opening. Except as permitted by law and subject to all applicable remedies, including forfeiture of bidder's security, bidders may not withdraw their bid during the 90 day period after the bid opening.

- > Replace the Bid Schedule pages BB-12 thru BB-13, with the attached revised Bid Schedule pages BB-12 thru BB-13. Changes include the addition of a Bid Item for "Aggregate Base (3-inch Layer)". Changed information is shown with bold italic text.
- > Section 10-3 Roadway Surface Preparation, Replace Paragraph 10-3.01 with the following (All references to a tack coat have been removed.):
 - <u>10-3.01 Description</u>: Roadway Surface Preparation will be used where shown on the plans and as directed by the Engineer and shall conform to the specifications. Roadway surface preparation shall consist of grinding/pulverizing of existing chip-seal where present on the roadway, as well as scarifying all remaining road base to a depth of 2-3 inches.
- > Section 10-4 Chip-Sealing, Replace Paragraph 10-4.01 with the following (All references to a tack coat have been removed):
 - <u>10-4.01 Description:</u> The intent of this project is to provide a Double Chip-Seal over the entire length of the roadway as shown on the pans. As the chip seal will be applied over a 3-inch layer of compacted aggregate base, it will slightly vary from certain sections of Section 37-2 of the Standard Specifications (primarily roadway preparation). The Double Chip-Sealing shall consist of a double application of bituminous binder and cover of screenings to be applied in accordance with Section 37-2 pf the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

> Section 10-4 Chip Sealing, Paragraph 10-4.03: The aggregate size for the chip seal initial and surface (second course) shall both be 3/8-inch.

> Add the attached Section 10-6 Aggregate Base.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that whereas the PRINCIPAL has submitted the accompanying proposal dated <u>September 25th</u>, <u>2020</u> to the OBLIGEE, for the **WWTP Access Road Improvements Project** (designated as the "Project") which proposal is hereby made a part hereof;

NOW THEREFORE, if the PRINCIPAL shall not withdraw said proposal within the ninety (90) day period following the opening of bids, and if the PRINCIPAL receives written notice that the Project is awarded to the PRINCIPAL and shall, within ten (10) calendar days of receiving such notice: enter into a written contract with the OBLIGEE in the form prescribed in the bid package issued by the OBLIGEE concerning the Project; and give insurance and bond with good and sufficient sureties guaranteeing the faithful performance and proper fulfillment of such contract and guaranteeing payment for labor and materials used for performance of the contract as required by law; and file with the OBLIGEE all required documents and do all other thing required in accordance with the bid package issued by the OBLIGEE concerning the Project for the contract between the PRINCIPAL and the OBLIGEE to become effective and for work to commence in accordance with the bid package issued by the OBLIGEE concerning the Project, or, in the event of withdrawal of the accompanying proposal within the ninety (90) day period following the opening of bids; or failure by the PRINCIPAL to enter into such contract with the OBLIGEE or to give the OBLIGEE such bonds or to file any other documents or to do any other things required in the bid package issued by the OBLIGEE for the Project, if the PRINCIPAL shall pay the OBLIGEE the difference between the total bid price in the accompanying proposal and the amount for which the OBLIGEE may procure the required performance, if the latter amount be in excess of the former, together with all costs incurred by the OBLIGEE in again attempting to let the Project, and if the said PRINCIPAL shall fully reimburse and save harmless the OBLIGEE from any damage sustained by the OBLIGEE through failure of the PRINCIPAL to enter into the written contract or to file the required performance or labor and material bonds, or to file any other required documents or to do any other things required for the contract between the PRINCIPAL and the OBLIGEE to become effective and the work to commence in accordance with the bid package issued by the OBLIGEE

concerning the Project, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise, it shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SURETY, for value received, hereby stipulates and agrees that no change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the bid or contract documents for the Project, or to the specifications included in the same, or to the work to be performed thereunder, or to the notice inviting bids, or to any other documents concerning the Project, shall in anywise affect SURETY's obligation under this bond, and SURETY hereby waives notice of any such change, extension of time, alteration or addition to such bid or contract documents.

In the event suit is brought upon this bond by the OBLIGEE and judgment is recovered, the SURETY shall pay all costs incurred by the OBLIGEE in such suit, including a reasonable attorney's fee to be fixed by the Court.
