AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Award of Contract to TerraCon Constructors, Inc. in the amount of \$141,808 for the Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project

RECOMMENDATIONS: Approve the attached resolution which takes the following actions regarding the Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project:

1. Authorize the Board of Directors to approve a construction contract with TerraCon Constructors, Inc. for the Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project based on their submitted bid of \$141,808.
2. Approve the overall Estimated Construction Budget of \$195,614, which includes the construction cost, a 10% contingency and monies for construction management and inspection.
3. Determining the project to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Based on the recommended award amount, staff is proposing the following overall budget:

Construction	\$141,808
Construction Contingency (10%)	\$ 14,180
<u>Estimated Construction Management & Inspection</u>	<u>\$ 39,625</u>
Total Estimated Project Construction Budget	\$195,614

Costs associated with this project will be paid from District funds.

BACKGROUND: The Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project consists of the replacement of approximately 300 feet of 8-inch transite water main with PVC C900 water main. The pipe, located on Mountain Meadow North between Hartmann Road and Donkey Hill Road, is a critical water main connecting the Zone 1 water tanks and Zone 1 residents. The pipe is known to be in poor condition and has been repaired multiple times. On March 4, 2019, the District authorized Coastland Engineering to prepare construction documents for the project.

Once the construction documents were completed and approved, the project was advertised for bids in accordance with the requirements of the California Public Contract Code. On July 11, 2019, District staff and the District Engineer conducted the bid opening and two (2) bids were received from Green Right O'Way Constructors, Inc. in the amount of \$160,549, and from Helmer & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$260,768.

The District Engineer reviewed the bid documents submitted by Green Right O'Way and found that their registration with the Department of Industrial had expired. The District's Attorney, Doug Coty, determined that the District could not legally award the contract to Green Right O'Way according to California Labor Code Sections 1725.5 and 1771.1. Helmer & Sons, Inc.'s bid was found to be responsive and complete, though substantially higher than the engineer's estimate. The District decided to reject all bids and re-bid the project.

In September, the project was again advertised for bids (without any changes in project scope) in accordance with the requirements of the California Public Contract Code. On October 17, 2019, District staff conducted the bid opening and five (5) bids were received.

Coleman Environmental Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$152,357.21

Engelke Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$160,053.00

Rege Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$211,944.00

Team Ghilotti, Inc. in the amount of \$237,141.00

Terracon Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$141,808.00

The lowest bid was from TerraCon Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$141,808, which was below the engineer's estimate of \$159,835.

The District Engineer reviewed TerraCon Constructors, Inc's bid documents and found them to be responsive and complete.

The award of the contract is to be based on the lowest responsive and responsible base bid received. Based on information received, staff is recommending that the District award the contract to TerraCon Constructors, Inc., for \$141,808 and approve the overall budget for the project.

If approved, the work is estimated to start in November 2019 and be completed by January 1, 2020.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH TERRACON CONSTRUCTORS, INC. FOR THE MOUNTAIN MEADOW NORTH WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND ESTABLISH AN OVERALL BUDGET

HIDDEN VALLEY LAKE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the water main in Mountain Meadow North is known to be in poor condition and has been repaired on multiple occasions; and

WHEREAS, contract bid documents were prepared for the replacement of this water main and the project was advertised for public bidding in accordance with the regulations of the California Public Contract Code; and

WHEREAS, bids for the project were publicly opened on October 17, 2019, in accordance with Section 4104.5 of the California Public Contract Code and other applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, five bids were received, the lowest of which was for \$141,808 from TerraCon Constructors, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that the bid from TerraCon Constructors, Inc. satisfies the bidding requirements for the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff has verified that TerraCon Constructors, Inc. possesses a valid California Contractor's License under the requested Class A, number 562511 (expires 11/30/19) as required to qualify to perform the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been found to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301(b) as it consists of replacement of existing facilities of both investor and publicly-owned utilities used to provide electric power, natural gas, sewerage, or other public utility services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District, Lake County, California, as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Community Services District.
2. In accordance with the California Public Contract Code Section 20160 *et seq.*, and other applicable laws, the Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District hereby finds the base bid of TerraCon Constructors, Inc. for the Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project to be the lowest, responsive bid and waives any irregularities in such bid in accordance with applicable law.
3. The contract for the Mountain Meadow North Water Main Replacement Project is hereby awarded to TerraCon Constructors, Inc. in the amount of \$141,808.00 conditioned on TerraCon Constructors, Inc. timely executing the Project contract and submitting all required

documents, including, but not limited to, executed bonds/surety, certificates of insurance, and endorsements, in accordance with the Project bid documents.

4. The President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute upon submission by TerraCon Constructors, Inc. all documents required pursuant to the Project bid documents for performance of the Project.
5. The overall construction budget for the Project be established at \$195,614.00.
6. District staff are hereby directed to issue a Notice of Award to TerraCon Constructors, Inc. for the project.
7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
8. All portions of this resolution are severable. Should any individual component of this Resolution be adjudged to be invalid and unenforceable by a body of competent jurisdiction, then the remaining resolution portions shall be and continue in full force and effect, except as to those resolution portions that have been adjudged invalid. The Board of Directors of the Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District hereby declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase and other portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more section subsection, clause sentence, phrase or other portion may be held invalid or unconstitutional.
