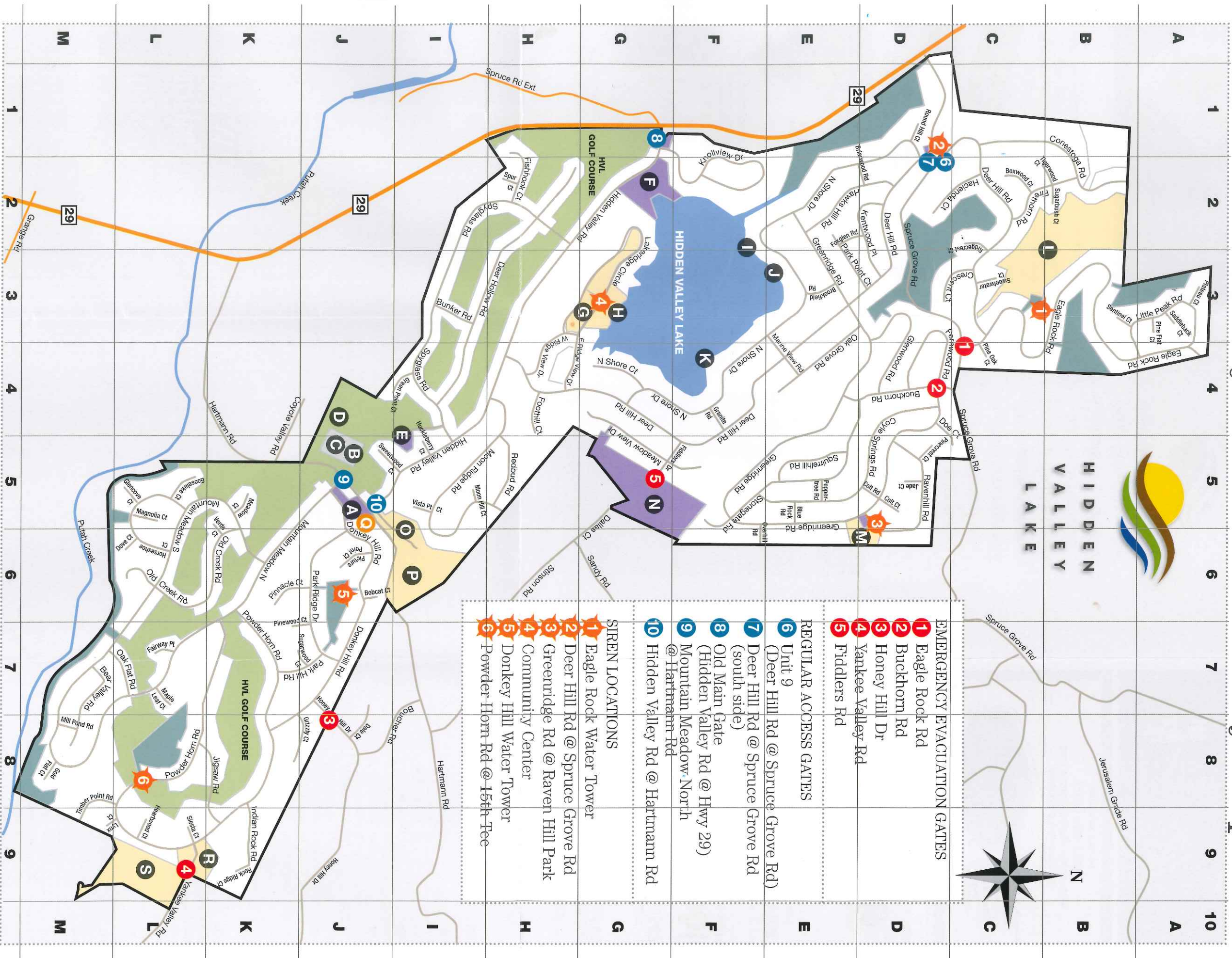
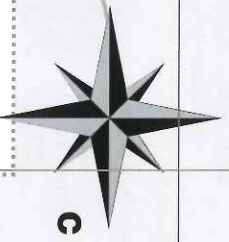


Hidden Valley Lake Community Map

Emergency Notification Siren System Demonstration

The Emergency Notification Siren System, (ENSS), and recently installed wildfire siren and evacuation system, was demonstrated on Saturday, August 19, 2017 from 1-3 PM at the Greenview Restaurant BBQ Picnic Area. Free Hotdogs and bottled water were provided.

ENSS will be used to warn Hidden Valley Lake members, tenants, and guests of an imminent catastrophic event, man made or natural. ENSS consists of six sirens, strategically placed within the subdivision. Although the sirens will be loudest within the Hidden Valley Lake gates, neighbors will be able to hear them.

In some cases, residents may not hear the sirens. Thus, there is an urgency to get all residents registered for NIXLE alerts. It is especially critical if residents are away from the community because NIXLE will send Alert or Advisory messages to cell phone regardless of location. If you're headed back from out of town, that's helpful to know what you may be dealing with.

Siren Sound

When activated, the emergency siren will sound for three minutes. If you hear the emergency alert tone, you should take the following action:

- Stop what you are doing.
- Evaluate your surroundings.
- Be prepared to take immediate self-protective action including up to evacuation.
- Prepare to receive information from sources such as NIXLE, media outlets, state, and local agencies.

Siren Testing

The first Saturday of every month at 12 Noon, siren testing will sound for 30 seconds and begin with a low tone, than ramping up to a much higher tone before tapering back down to the low tone. In the event of a real emergency, the sirens will emit a wailing tone, low, ramping to high, holding for 10 seconds, then tapering to low, followed with two cycles of low to high. This will continue for three minutes.
